- The decision of the C.A.R. personnel is final.
- All adoptions must meet the criteria of C.A.R.'s GENERAL ADOPTION POLICIES.
- If approved you must carefully read the terms of our Adoption Contract and be willing to agree to the terms.
- Finally, you must pay a *non-refundable* Adoption Fee as determined by C.A.R.
