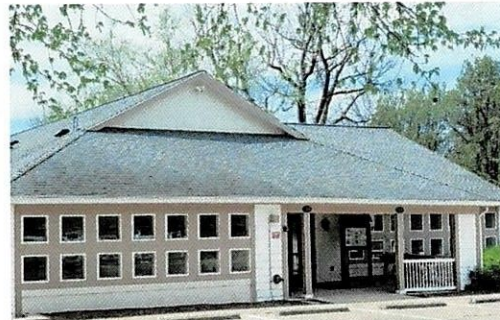
During your training session you will receive a guided tour and care instructions for the animals.

Country Acres Rescue Welcomes a partnership with Members of our community.

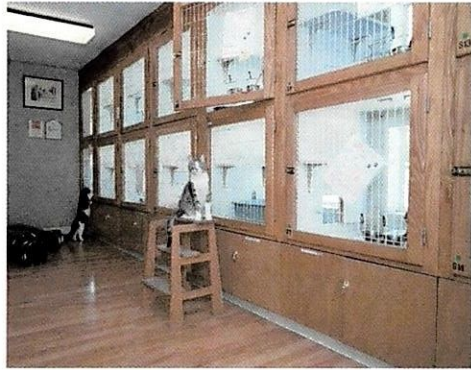
To become a volunteer, the Minimum requirements are:

*We do not accept Service hours or Parent/Child volunteers unless the child is at least 16 years of age.*
